## Course Description

Understand the fundamentals of cooperative agreements, how they differ from grants, and how *substantial involvement* is defined. This course will enable you to identify and select the appropriate award instrument, manage agency involvement, and take the steps necessary to transition from a grant to a cooperative agreement. Federal personnel responsible for determining the appropriate award instrument, drafting cooperative agreement program announcements or award documents, and/or managing agency involvement in cooperative agreements will benefit from this course.

- Identify the boundaries between standard post-award oversight and substantial involvement and the consequences for overreach
