Course Description

Learn about standards of conduct, managing and avoiding conflicts of interest, privacy protection requirements, and lobbying restrictions within the context of federal grants. This course goes beyond the government's standard ethics training to cover issues specific to the grants environment and uses real-world examples and discussions to challenge participants to think critically. This is an elective course in the Federal Track of the GMCP™.

Intended Audience

Program personnel who award or monitor federal grants and/or cooperative agreements, and supervisors of grants managers will benefit from this course.

Course Learning Objectives

- Recognize legislative actions and judicial decisions that affect the standards of ethical conduct for executive branch employees
- Determine whether actions of federal personnel comply with the regulations at 5 CFR 2635, Standards of Ethical Conduct for Employees of the Executive Branch
- Assess agency activities to determine whether they violate restrictions on lobbying
- Assess scenarios to identify ethical concerns and determine an appropriate response
- Recognize restrictions on requirements that agencies can impose on recipients
- Explore methods for ensuring fairness in the grant review and award process
