You'll learn about appropriation law constraints, flexibilities, and unique DoD exceptions with regard to the legal availability of appropriated funds, how to apply DoD funding principles and obligation rules, and recognize what constitutes a legal obligation.

Participants will be budget analysts, auditors, contracting officers, program managers, and all departmental accountable officials working for or with DoD who need to know the exceptions and constraints that apply to DoD only.
