## Course Description

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Understand the nuances of the DoD Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution (PPBE) process that determines how much funding programs receive. You will gain knowledge of the procedures and rules governing budget development within DoD and how to implement the PPBE process in the Army. You will practice developing a performance plan and allocating resources through a capstone Army program exercise.

## Intended Audience

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This course is designed for Army financial, program and project, resource, and management professionals who need to understand the essential elements, procedures, and rules governing the development and execution of budgets within the Department of the Army Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution (PPBE).

## Course Learning Objectives

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- Explain the roles and relationships of the building blocks of the planning, programming, and budgeting system for the Army
- Participate in the development, justification, and review of the Army program and budget submissions
- Identify purpose and content of key Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution (PPBE) events and documents, who influences them, and their relative timing in the overall process
- Outline the congressional enactment process and explain its influence on PPBE
- Explain the basic elements of DoD and Army budget execution
- Analyze the relationship between budget timetables and funds management requirements for a representative DoD acquisition program
