**Course Title:** CON 216: Legal Considerations in Contracting

## 1. What business or organizational need does this course address?

Take a close look at the legal considerations that must be taken into account during the procurement process. You will learn the basic principles and sources of law relevant to procurement through this Federal Acquisition Certification Contracting (FAC-C) and Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) Level II certification training course. You will also gain an understanding of other legal issues that may arise during a contract, including protests, assignment of claims, disputes, fraud, contractor debt, performance issues, and contract termination.

**Note:** If you are not looking for Level II Certification, consider *Federal Contract Law* as an alternative.

## 2. Who should attend?

This course is designed for contracting personnel pursuing FAC-C or DAWIA Level II certification.

## 3. What will I learn how to do in this course?

- Discuss the legal and ethical principles that apply to government contracts
- Identify essential fiscal laws that apply to contracts
- Identify legal considerations related to intellectual property
- Identify different processes by which challenges may be filed against a federal acquisition
- Define the legal obligations of both parties when a contract performance issue arises
- Discuss formal dispute resolution procedures under the Contract Disputes statute
- Identify criminal, civil, and administrative remedies for contract fraud
- Select the processes and procedures for terminating a contract
- Choose the appropriate tool for recovering monies owed the government

## 4. What kinds of activities are included in this course?

Lecture, discussion, interpretation and application of case study materials, preparation and presentation of a case study, and independent readings
