1. What business or organizational need does this course address?

Become equipped to design and implement an effective enterprise risk management (ERM) program tailored to your governing body's mission and goals. Incorporating ERM enhances the governing body's ability to achieve strategic objectives across all government activities, prevents fraud and waste through proactive risk identification and mitigation, and strengthens governance by fostering accountability and aligning resources to manage risks effectively. You will gain the skills to enhance compliance, prevent fraud and waste, and integrate ERM into decision-making and governance processes.

2. Who should attend?

This course is designed for government employees across all job series and government activities who are responsible for identifying, managing, and mitigating risk within their agencies. It is ideal for managers, risk officers, strategic planners, internal auditors, and others involved in aligning risk management with agency goals.

3. What will I learn how to do in this course?

- Define enterprise risk management (ERM) and its relationship to traditional risk management and internal control
- Assess an organization's risk maturity, organizational, and governance structures to determine its readiness for an ERM program
- Implement risk identification, risk assessment, and risk monitoring within the structure of an ERM framework
- Integrate ERM into strategic planning, budgeting, and performance management processes
- Incorporate cybersecurity risk considerations into ERM implementation
- Apply techniques that have proven effective in addressing common challenges in ERM implementation
