1. What business or organizational need does this course address?

Learn techniques to develop, analyze, and manage program financial plans to successfully execute a budget. This course explores the laws and procedures that guide the budgeting process, including coverage of the policies outlined in OMB Circular A-11 along with other relevant financial management policies.

Participants enrolled in this course are typically federal employees who take part in their organization's budget execution and need to become familiar with the principles, laws, and procedures affiliated with proper budget execution.

3. What will I learn how to do in this course?

- Visualize the federal budget process and timeline and practice developing an Annual Performance Plan
- Use the provisions of appropriations law to identify violations
- Differentiate between the two methods of federal accounting and financial reporting requirements
- Practice and evaluate how to develop, track, and control a financial plan
- Apply the principles of budget execution
